TEST INFORMATION

- u Leadline should be performed at the walk
- u The horse must be lead at the shoulder, on the left side.
- u Leader must hold the lead at least one foot from the clip in the right hand.
- u Rider must be seen to be directing the horse.
- u The horse on the Leadline at all times.
- u A caller is permitted.
- u The rider should be smiling.
- u ARENA SIZE: Standard

Medium Walk:
Regular and unconstrained with the handler taking care to keep the rider safely balanced in the saddle during movements.
